Brazil Hub has an afternoon dedicated to Youth

The youth panel at the Brazil Hub will be one of the spaces in which youth will be occupying speaking and leadership space, being an afternoon entirely dedicated to youth, from 3:30pm to 7:00pm (Egypt time) / 10:30am to 2pm (Brasília time) on November 16th. The Panel is an opportunity for the Brazilian youth present at COP27 to show their articulation agendas and demands, having several target audiences among the youth themselves, decision-makers and the third-sector organizations present.

There will be four events within the themes of climate education, forests, religiosity and audiovisual, and climate justice and technology, besides a moment of exchange and musical interventions. The panel will have the opening facilitation led by Engajamundo, followed by a panel on Strategies and methodologies for Climate Education in Brazil in the first block. After a break, the second panel will focus on youth, forests and the Amazon. The third block will present a documentary on religiosity, climate crisis and audiovisual. The fourth panel will talk about climate justice, technologies and youth. And for the closing, Mandí and Mapinguari will lead an exchange with music and dance performances.
